Well, March of 2020 is one for the history books. Few of us had any idea a month ago just how severely this new virus would affect nearly every aspect of our lives – including, of course, church. I want to take a moment to commend our UUCY Board of Trustees for making the difficult decision to suspend all in-person activities in early March when they had to.

It's been a tough month since then. I've "seen" many of you online, and talked to several more on the phone, and have even bumped into a couple of you at the grocery store. But we haven't gathered as a community not only of souls but also of bodies for several weeks now, and that is hard. It is made harder still when we realize that this situation is probably going to go on for at least several more weeks — indeed, as I write this I've just heard that Washington public schools will be closed for the remainder of the school year.

I'm well aware that in addition to the question of how long we'll not be in direct contact are the questions about how we'll come back together once we know it's safe to do so. In hindsight, our Board's decision to shut programs down, like our various government and civic leader's decisions to shut down other normal activities, was the easy one. The harder decision is going to be when and under what circumstances we can be safe gathering again. And that is likely to not be nearly as swift a decision with a short time frame – we'll likely have weeks or even months of transition bringing things back to "normal." Whatever that winds up meaning.

In the meantime, I encourage you all to reach out as best you can, to remember that this community is at heart a collection of people who care for one another and find joy and meaning in our participation. Even as we've been taking in the importance of "social distancing," we may be becoming more aware than ever before of our fundamental need to be social creatures, to connect and be a part of community. There are many ways to maintain these connections, either by using the latest state-of-the-art technology, if that floats your boat, to old-fashioned tried and true ways like the telephone and letters.

And please, let me know if you're feeling a need to connect. We're still here for each other!

And though I may not "see you in church" soon, I'm with you in spirit.


